KONTIORALLI ("Bear Rally") is one of the oldest and biggest annual motorcyclist meetings in Finland. It was first organized in 1967 at Kontiolahti, Finland. The same people who created the first meetings, founded the motorcycle club called Moottoripyöräkerho 69 ry (MP69). In few decades MP69 grew to be one of the biggest motorcycle clubs in Finland!

Kontioralli is organized by MP69 together with a changing local motorcycle club. The place of the meeting changes every year.

For over 10 years the meeting has been exclusively for the members of MP69. For



only this year 2022 we want to open the meeting for every motorcyclist in Finland and in the world!

To come to the meeting, you must first arrive to the Control Point. At the Control Point, you receive the map to the meeting, usually 10 - 100 km away.



In Kontioralli we offer you a place to meet fellow motorcyclists, enjoy nature, go to sauna, eat and drink, listen to music and experience different activities which that particular location has to offer. People usually sleep in their own tents etc., but few indoor rooms/cottages are available also.
